To garden for the bays...these are a **must** to avoid.



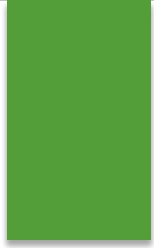

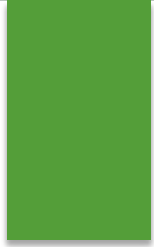

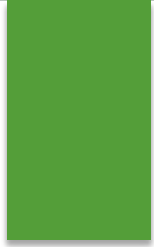
