Old Business

Decked Out Debrief M. Carter

- Mark gave a debrief on Decked Out, started with a thank you for volunteering, sponsoring, attending the event.
- Net of \$45k for the event. Auctioneer said the auction items were some of the best he ever had
- Live auction items per package increased, and the silent auction didn't pull in quite as much as last year.
- Asked for any more input and shared Dave's input.
- Bar back ups at the event, but attendees stood in line in front of the auction items.
- Positive feedback on diversity and amount of food, oysters were a hit and correct quantity ordered
- Check-in glitch at the beginning of the event with name tags. Susie suggested Companies on name tags as well.
- Live auction items because we had a lot of local folks, maybe we look at items/places that are a bit more far away St. Michaels, Easton, etc., could encourage interactions with other environmental groups.
- Jerry feedback acoustics still not great at the outdoor venue; Susie thought it was a little louder but still hard to talk over big groups talking.

New Business

2023 Events Plan M. Carter

- Meeting with other directors on staff to plan out 2023
- Decked Out (Sept. 21), Native Plant Sale (tentative date May 6, 2023)
- Active Lifestyle Event: Paddle Board Race (East of Maui) canceled in 2022;
 Development will help support / organize this event for 2023 to help boost event
- NEW active lifestyle event idea: 5k running/walking event (couple hundred people); could add on to Native Plant Sale event day; Fresh Pond Prickly Pear Trail
- Run targets a demographic that might not know about us
- Bethany Brewing would like to do some kind of benefit event run, bike ride, etc.
- NEW event idea: something unique like RAGNAR events; 10-person team relay with longer distance; James Farm could be base camp; bring in next generation of supporters; larger registration fee due to team aspect (could be 2024 event)
- Speaking Events to put our name out there across the watershed
- Trivia Nights: At DCYS participants' restaurants to host Inland Bays trivia nights
- Aimee suggested a Guest Bartender event as another addition to event list for 2023
