Vendors were pretty good - food and beer did well, 302 did great, artist who made the mugs was very successful at event, Big Chill gave feedback that it was good to see a different venue space. Nicole suggested maybe mug artist could be present at Native Plant Sale.

### "Donor Cultivation" Events Recap

- 2 donor cultivation events in June 1st one at the Wolcott's in Bay View Park. Was a meet & greet with the Center (Christophe and Dev team) with several of their neighbors. Will go back in the fall (September) for maybe a more fundraiser-focused event.
- June 29 at the Hardwicks in Rehoboth Country Club. Invited 60 of their neighbors and friends over for a fundraiser night with oysters, wine, beers, and snacks. Development and Science team attended, as well as Board and Dev Com team (Pat C. and Dave K.). Hardwicks contributed \$10,000, and their attendees donated about another ~\$6,000. Total at the end of the day will be nearly \$21,000. Dave's thoughts thoughtfully planned event, spoke to Lori about the community feel of the oyster gardening program, worked together as a whole neighborhood. Community-based approach.
- Idea could we do HOA programs like a community garden? Communities on the water could be more involved with projects that help protect the watershed.
- Observed outcome from Christophe: great volunteer interest as well as donor cultivation
